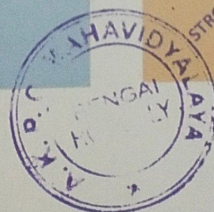
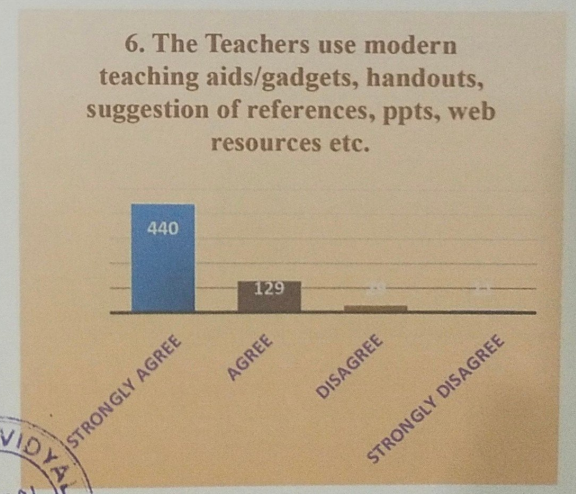
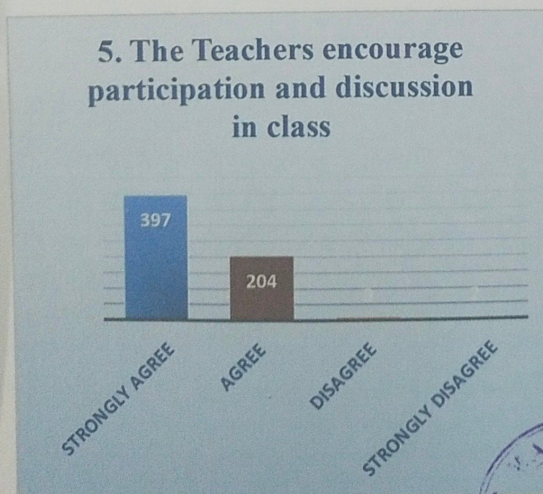
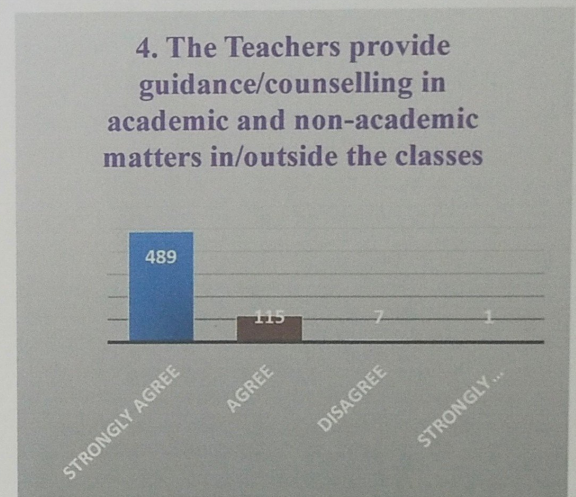
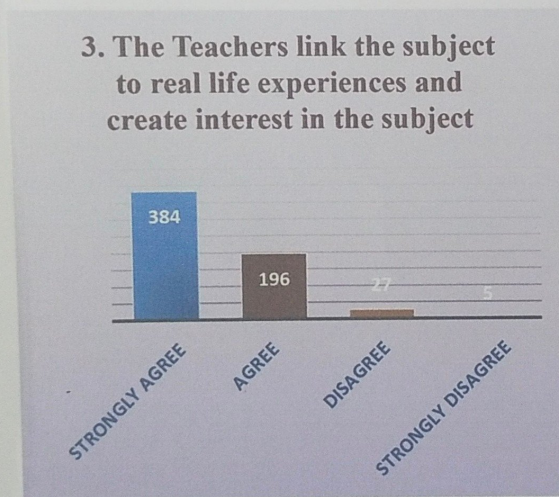
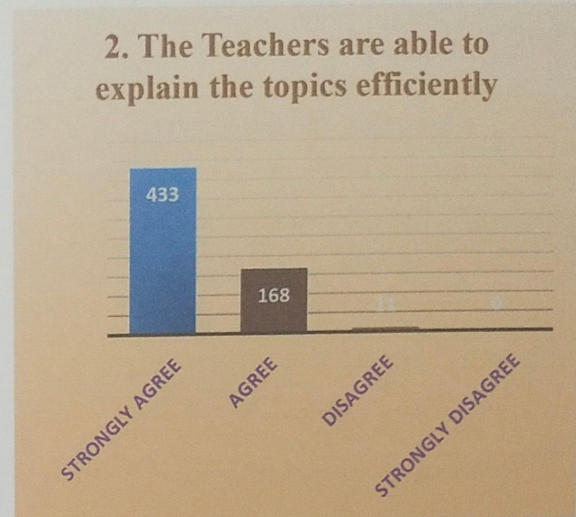
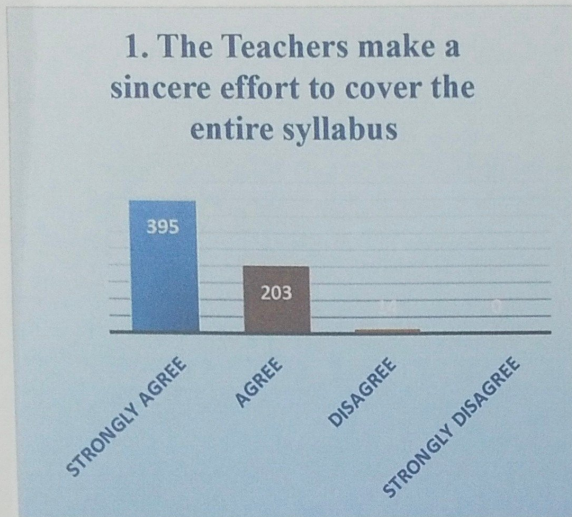
- **Collection of Data:** The feedback is collected manually by circulating the feedback forms.

- **Circulation of Action Taken Report:** The approved action taken report is circulated among the staff members through the IQAC. Action taken report acts as a plan for the next academic year. Department level meetings are also held to execute and implement the action plan.

## Key findings from the survey of Students

### 1. Instructor Performance:

- Students express overwhelming satisfaction with the instructor's ability to cover the syllabus comprehensively, explain topics clearly, and use examples effectively. Specifically, 96% are pleased with the syllabus coverage, 92% appreciate the clarity of explanations, and 94% value the use of examples and applications.

### 2. Overall Quality of Education:

- High student satisfaction rates indicate that the college is effectively providing quality education. Factors contributing to this satisfaction include the quality of teaching, availability of resources, and the overall educational environment.

### 3. Mentorship and Additional Courses:

- The mentorship program and Add-On/Certificate courses offered by various departments are well-regarded by students.

### 4. Learning Outcome-Based Curriculum (LOCF):

- Students positively view the implementation of the LOCF, appreciating the continuous assessment and support for struggling students.

### 5. Teacher Attitude and Evaluation Fairness:

- Students are content with teachers' attitudes and the fairness of evaluations.

### 6. Extra-Curricular Activities:

- Feedback on NCC, NSS, and other extracurricular activities is generally positive.

### 7. Cells and Grievance Redressal:

- Approximately 95% of students provide positive feedback on the activities of various Cells, including the Prevention of Sexual Harassment Cell and Anti-Ragging Cell. About 90% of students also report favorable views on the Grievance Redressal Cell.

## Areas for Improvement:

### 1. Add-On/Certificate Courses:

- More Add-On/Certificate courses should be introduced to enhance skill development and increase employability.

### 2. Library Resources:

- The library needs to expand its collection of books.

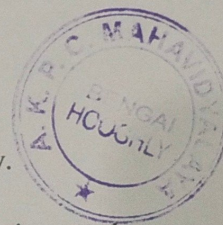

- The library should expand its collection of books, including the latest reference materials, textbooks, and journals relevant to the syllabus.

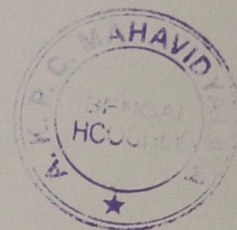

- Students traveling from distant locations should have access to improved hostel facilities. Renovation and enhancement of the hostel are essential to make it more accommodating and comfortable.

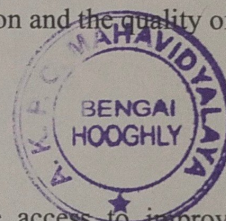
